THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE.

(Chapter 5).

UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE THE POWERS SPECIFIED IN THE FIRST COLUMN CONFERRED BY THE ORDINANCE MENTIONED IN THE SECOND COLUMN HAVE BEEN DELEGATED BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR TO THE OFFICER MENTIONED IN THE THIRD COLUMN.

Power conferred	Ordinance	Officer
To appoint officers, including female searchers, other than wardens and sub-wardens, necessary for the purposes of the Mining Ordinance.	The Mining Ordinance, Chapter 196 (section 7).	The Commissioner of Lands and Mines.
To grant, refuse and revoke licences to prospect for radioactive minerals on Crown Lands, Colony lands or any other lands in the Colony, after consultation with the Chief Secretary in each case.	The Radio-Active Minerals Ordinance, Chapter 198 (section 6).	The Commissioner of Lands and Mines.
