

THE COCONUT PRODUCTS (CONTROL) ACT

(Cap. 69:05)

NOTICE

UNDER SECTION 12(1)

I hereby fix as the minimum prices to be paid by every manufacturer for copra purchased by him, the following prices —

Grade 1 Copra (as defined hereunder)	42.5c. per lb.
Grade 11 Copra (as defined hereunder)	41.5c. per lb.

“Grade 1 Copra” means copra which is fully dried, which is made from fully matured nuts and which is free from mould and rancidity.

“Grade 11 Copra” means copra which is free from mould and rancidity but which in respect of degree of dryness or the maturity of the coconuts from which it is made is not of sufficiently light quality for inclusion in Grade 1.
