

NOTICE

WHEREAS by Section 18(1) of the Roads Ordinance (Chapter 277), the Director of Public Works has caused to be deposited in the Office of the Public Works Department in Georgetown in the County of Demerara a notice accompanied by drawing Number R/S-41 showing the proposed deviation of the existing East Bank Demerara road across Plantation Diamond and has advertised the deposit of such notice and the general purport thereof in the Gazette of the 28th May, 4th and 11th June, 1960.

AND WHEREAS the only objection delivered to the said Director has with his report thereon been duly transmitted by him to the Governor in Council in accordance with Section 18(2) of the said Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE notice is hereby given in accordance with Section 18(3) of the said Ordinance that after considering the said proposals and the said objection and the said report the Governor in Council has determined that the said road be deviated as proposed as aforesaid.
