

NOTICE**EAST DEMERARA WATER CONSERVANCY ORDINANCE**

(Chapter 236)

In pursuance of the provisions of Section 26 of the East Demerara Water Conservancy Ordinance, Chapter 236, and in accordance with paragraph (1) of Article 22 of the Constitution of British Guiana, and by virtue and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Acting Governor has approved the following additional rates for the year 1962, which have been submitted by the East Demerara Water Conservancy Board :—
