IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER
BY SECTION 10 OF THE MINING ACT 1989,
I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

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| Citation and Commencement | 1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission (Prospecting for uranium) Reservation Order 2007 and shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 24 th day of September, 2007. |
| Reservation | 2. The areas hereinafter described in the Schedule below are hereby reserved for prospecting operations by the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission for the purpose as stated in Clause 1 herein, but WITHOUT PREJUDICE to the power of the Minister (as representing the State) to permit any person to carry on in the scheduled area prospecting operations (including operations incidental thereto) for the benefit, wholly or partly, of the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission. |


SCHEDULE

Tract of state land located in the Cuyuni Mining District No. 4 as shown on Terra Surveys Topographic Map 15SW, 15NW, 14SE, 22NE, and 23NW at scale 1: 50,000 with reference point 'X' located at the confluence of the Cuyuni River and the Ekereku River located with geographical co-ordinates of longitude 60° 43' 56"W and latitude 6° 12' 29"N.

Thence up the right bank of the Cuyuni River for a distance of approximately 1510 yards, to point of commencement; Point A, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 60°58'5"W and latitude 6°42'59"N, thence down the right bank of the Cuyuni River, for a distance of approximately 1 mile 1473 yards, to Point B, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 60°56'32"W and latitude 6°43'22"N, thence at true bearing of 76°, for a distance of approximately 12 miles 749 yards, to Point C, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 60°46'0"W and latitude 6°46'0"N, thence at true bearing of 179°, for a distance of approximately 4 miles 189 yards, to Point D, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 60°45'58"W and latitude 6°42'26"N, thence at true bearing of 166°, for a distance of approximately 26 miles 1428 yards, to Point E, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 60°40'24"W and latitude 6°19'49"N, thence at true bearing of 262°, for a distance of approximately 30 miles 1341 yards, to Point F, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 61°7'0"W and latitude 6°16'0"N, thence down the right bank of the Wenamu River, for a distance of approximately 1 mile 742 yards, to Point G, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 61°7'5"W and latitude 6°16'42"N, thence at true bearing of 7°, for a distance of approximately 27 miles 54 yards, to Point H, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 61°10'0"W and latitude 6°40'0"N, thence at true bearing of 76°, for a distance of approximately 14 miles 106 yards, to the point of commencement at Point A.

Thus enclosing an area of approximately 544,841 acres, save and except all lands lawfully held or occupied.
