(c) "Corporation" means the Guyana National Trading Corporation, being a public corporation established under the Public Corporations Act 1988;

(d) "property" means the property described in the Schedule, being property belonging to the Corporation;

(e) "Purchaser" means Mr. Ramond Ratnam of 21 Camp Street, Lacytown, Georgetown, Demerara.

3. Pursuant to the Agreement and subject to the terms and conditions specified therein, the property, is transferred to the Purchaser with effect from the appointed day.

Part of the northern front quarter of Lot 11 (eleven) situate in the empolder of the Town of New Amsterdam, measuring 258 (two hundred and fifty-eight) feet in depth and 60 3/4 (sixty and three quarter) feet in breadth bounded as follows: on the east by part of said lot belonging to E. Smyles, now belonging to Henry James west by the public front dam trench, north by lot numbered 10 (ten) and south by the lane running through the center of the said lot number 11 (eleven) together with all the buildings and erections thereon.
