



WHEREAS by section 2 of the Pounds Ordinance, Chapter 82, it is enacted that the Governor may from time to time by proclamation to be published in the Gazette establish pounds in those parts of the Colony which to him seem fit;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that a pound shall be established at Schepmoed, adjacent to the Government compound in the Mara Land Development Scheme, in the county of Berbice:

NOW, THEREFORE, I do hereby, by this proclamation, establish a pound to be kept at Schepmoed, adjacent to the Government compound in the Mara Land Development Scheme in the county of Berbice.

Given under my Hand and the Public Seal of the Colony at Government House, British Guiana, this 11th day of March, 1966, and in the fifteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
