

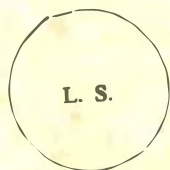

PROCLAMATION



By His Excellency, SIR DAVID JAMES GARDINER ROSE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander in the Royal Victorian Order, Member of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Guyana.

WHEREAS by Proclamation dated the fourth day of November 1968, issued under article 82(2) of the Constitution of Guyana (hereinafter referred to as "the Constitution"), the Parliament of Guyana (hereinafter referred to as "Parliament") was dissolved with effect from Tuesday, the fifth day of November, 1968;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by article 81(1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Guyana and shall begin at such time (not being later than four months from the end of the preceding session if Parliament has been dissolved) as the Governor-General shall appoint by proclamation:

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of article 81(1) of the Constitution, and by virtue and in exercise of all powers enabling me in that behalf, I do hereby proclaim that a session of Parliament shall be held in the Parliament Chamber at the Public Buildings, Georgetown, Guyana, and shall begin at 9.30 o'clock in the forenoon on Friday, the third day of January, 1969.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of Guyana at Guyana House, Georgetown, Guyana, this 30th day of December, 1968, and in the seventeenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
