51:02, I MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS-**

1. These Regulations, which amend the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Regulations 2010.

of the First
Schedule to
the
Principal
Act.

2. The First Schedule to the Principal Act is amended as follows --

(a) by inserting immediately after paragraph 3 (c) the following --

“No fee shall be payable for the issuance of a licence for a motor vehicle classified as a yellow cab for a period of ten years commencing from the date when such vehicle first benefited from the provisions of these Regulations.”;

(b) by inserting under the heading “B-Other Fees” at the end of paragraph


“14. For certificate of fitness -” the following-

“No fee shall be payable for the issuance of a certificate of fitness for a motor vehicle classified as a yellow cab for a period of ten years commencing from the date when such vehicle first benefited from the provisions of these Regulations.”;

- (c) by inserting the following definition in its proper alphabetical order –

“yellow cab” means a motor vehicle that is painted in corporate yellow as specified by the Minister of Home Affairs, registered and used mainly for the purpose of carrying persons for hire or reward.”
