THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT  
(Cap. 36:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTIONS 19, 20, 21, 24 AND 51 OF THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS :—

1. These Regulations, which amend the National Insurance and Social Security (Sickness Benefit Medical Care) Regulations 1981\*, may be cited as The National Insurance and Social Security (Sickness Benefit Medical Care) (Amendment) Regulations 1989. <sup>Citation.</sup>

2. Regulation 2(2) of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the full stop at the end thereof of a colon and the insertion thereafter of the following proviso — <sup>Amendment of regulation 2 (2) of the Principal Regulations.</sup>

“Provided that in the case of a claim for the reimbursement of the cost of providing orthopaedic or prosthetic appliances, or any other care of a similar nature as may be approved by the General Manager, it shall not be necessary for the insured person to prove that he was incapacitated.”
