THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT
(Cap. 36:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER
BY SECTIONS 21 AND 51 OF THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND
SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING
REGULATIONS :—

Citation. 1. These Regulations, which amend the National Insurance and Social Security (Claims and Payments) Regulations*, may be cited as the National Insurance and Social Security (Claims and Payments) (Amendment) Regulations 1989.

Amendment of the Principal Regulations. 2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended in the following respects —

- (a) in regulation 9 —
 - (i) by the insertion, in paragraph (a), after the words “maternity benefit” of the words “where such benefit does not consist of a single payment”; /
 - (ii) by the insertion, in paragraph (c), after the words “old age Benefit,” of the words “maternity benefit,”; ✓
- (b) in regulation 14(1) (b), by the insertion after subparagraph (ii) of the following paragraph as paragraph (iii) —

*Cap. 36:01 Subsidiary Legislation

“(iii) in respect of maternity grant. the period of six months from the week of confinement;”;

(c) in regulation 14(2)(B), by the insertion after the words “claim is made” of the words “and where such benefit consists of a single payment”.
