THE POLICE ACT

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 99 OF THE POLICE ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the Police Regulations,* may be cited as the Police (Amendment) Regulations 1989. Citation.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the substitution for regulations 118 and 119 of the following regulation. Amendment of the Regulations. Principal

*Annual vacation leave and vacation allowance. 118. The Commissioner may grant annual vacation leave and vacation allowance to non commissioned officers or constables in accordance with the conditions, set out from time to time by the Ministry responsible for the public service, for other public officers of approximately the same category,

subject to such modifications to those conditions as the Minister may deem appropriate.”

3. Regulation 120 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows -

- (a) in paragraph (a), by the substitution for the word “Vacation” of the words “Annual vacation” and by the deletion of the words “granted under (a), (b) or (c) hereof”;
- (b) by the deletion of paragraph (b);
- (c) in paragraph (c), by the substitution for the word “vacation” of the words “annual vacation”.

Amendment

4. Regulation 121 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows -

- (a) by the substitution for the word “vacation” of the words “annual vacation”.
- (b) by the deletion of the words “in accordance with the scale authorised in regulation 119 (a), (b) and (c).
