Made Under

THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT

(Cap. 36:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTIONS 14, 20, 21, 39 AND 51 OF THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the National Insurance and Social Security (Benefit) Regulations*, may be cited as the National Insurance and Social Security (Benefit) (Amendment) Regulations 1979 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st July, 1978.

Citation and commencement.

2. Regulation 29 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following proviso —

Amendment of Regulation 29 of the Principal Regulations.

“Provided that nothing in the foregoing provisions of this Regulation shall be construed as disentitling a woman to payment of maternity benefit by reason only of a variation in the dates of the commencement and the end of the period aforesaid”.
