BRITISH GUIANA

REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 273 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1966, and shall be construed and read as one with the Customs Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Sub-paragraph (d) of paragraph (1) of regulation 153 of the Principal Regulations shall be deleted.
