REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 280).

UNDER SECTION 98(3) OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1967, and shall come into operation on the 1st October, 1967.

2. Part A of the first schedule to the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for item 6 of the following —

“6 (i) For any agricultural motor tractor and trailer which are used for the sole purpose of carrying agricultural machinery, appliances and produce or any of them to or from, or to and from, any cultivated plantation, lot or farm within a radius of 6 miles thereof but not in Georgetown or New Amsterdam	120.00
(ii) For any agricultural motor tractor used alone for the said purpose	20.00
