GUYANA

REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE COLONIAL MEDICAL SERVICE ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 134)

UNDER SECTION 52 OF THE COLONIAL MEDICAL SERVICE ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE MEDICAL BOARD:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Sicknurses and Dispensers (Payment of Fees) Regulations, 1969 and shall be construed and read as one with the Sicknurses and Dispensers (Payment of Fees) Regulations, *hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and all amendments thereto.

2. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended.

(a) by renumbering the regulation as regulation 3; and

(b) by the substitution for the words "one dollar" in paragraph (1) of the renumbered regulation, of the words "fifteen dollars".

3. The following regulation shall be inserted in the Principal Regulations as Regulation 2 —

2. Every person registered as a student sicknurse and dispenser, shall, upon payment of a fee of ten dollars in such circumstances as the Board may direct, be eligible to attend such lectures for his course of training as the Board shall provide." "Fee for attendance at lectures"

4. Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended —

(a) by renumbering the regulation as regulation 4; and

(b) by the insertion immediately after the word "dollars" in the renumbered regulation, of the words "per year".
