THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 132)

UNDER SECTION 97 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE
POSTMASTER GENERAL WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office Money Order (Amendment) Regulations, 1969, and shall be construed and read as one with the Post Office Money Order Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and all amendments thereto.

2. Regulation 13 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the figures "5,000" for the figures "2,000".
