**ANIMALS (MOVEMENT) AND DISEASE PREVENTION ACT 2003**  
**(No.14 of 2003)**

**IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 24 OF**  
**THE ANIMALS (MOVEMENT) AND DISEASE PREVENTION ACT 2003,**  
**I MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS: -**

Citation. 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Animals (Movement) and Disease Prevention (Sale of Chicks) Regulations 2007.

H/H 2. With effect from the commencement of these Regulations, the owners and operators of hatcheries shall not sell baby chicks, which have not been vaccinated against Inclusion Body Hepatitis (Hydropericardium Syndrome) (H/H).

Fowl Pox,  
Gomboro. 3. With effect from one month after the commencement of these Regulations, the owners and operators of hatcheries shall not sell baby chicks which have not been vaccinated against Mareks, Fowl Pox and Gomboro (Infectious Bursal Disease).

Offences. 4. An owner or operator of a hatchery who contravenes section 2 or 3 commits an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars and to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months.
