REGULATIONS TO AMEND THE DEEDS REGISTRY FEES REGULATIONS, 1933, WITH RESPECT TO THE FEES TO BE CHARGED AND TAKEN IN THE DEEDS REGISTRY.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Deeds Registry Fees Regulations, 1934, and shall be construed with the Deeds Registry Fees Regulations, 1933, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations. Short Title.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended—

(a) by substituting the following for item 13—

“13. For attending execution (or to proof thereof) of lease other than a long lease, or a transfer, assignment or surrender of such a lease, depositing registering and annotating ... \$2 00”

(b) by deleting the words “and, if required, registering same,” in item 21.

(c) by substituting “\$5.00” for “\$8.00” as the specified fee under item 25.

(d) by inserting the following item after item 25—

“ 25A. For recording, including certificate of record, depositing, or registering a special power of Attorney for the sole purpose of selling, purchasing, conveying, transferring, or accepting transfer of any bonds, debentures, scrip, stock, shares or other securities and for certificate of Registrar on copy, but exclusive of copying fees under item 51, an inclusive fee of ... \$1 00 ”

(e) by inserting the following item after item 35—

“ 35A. For further certificate as to such encumbrances where a levy is not made within one month of the original or later certificate, or where the sale is not advertised within one month of the levy or where the sale is to be re-advertised, including search ... \$.50 ”
