

REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE NATURE AND USE OF BRAKES ON BICYCLES.

1.—(a) Every bicycle shall be fitted with an efficient braking system.

Power to
stop and
examine

(b) Any member of the Police Force in uniform may stop and examine any bicycle in any public way with a view to ascertaining whether the provisions of this regulation are being complied with.

2. These Regulations shall come into force on 1st January, 1938.
