REGULATIONS TO AMEND THE MINING REGULATIONS, 1931, WITH RESPECT TO THE ROYALTY PAYABLE ON PRECIOUS STONES.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Mining (Amendment) Regulations, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Mining Regulations, 1931, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations) and any Regulations amending the same. Short Title.

2. Regulation 127 of the Principal Regulations as amended by regulation 3 of the Mining (Amendment) Regulations (No. 2), 1938, is hereby revoked and the following is substituted therefor:— New Regulation substituted for Regulation 127 of the Principal Regulations.

“Amount of royalty on precious stones. 127. The royalty payable on all precious stones including borts and rubbish shall be at the rate of fifteen cents for each carat.”

Made by the Governor in Council under section 98 of the Mining (Consolidation) Ordinance, Cap. 175, this 19th day of September, 1939.
