REGULATIONS FURTHER TO AMEND THE RICE (EXPORT BLENDING AND GRADING) REGULATIONS, 1934.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Rice (Export Blending and Grading) Regulations, 1939, and shall be construed with the Rice (Export Blending and Grading) Regulations, 1934, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations. Short title.

2. Regulation 9 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following proviso :— Proviso added to regulation 9 of the Principal Regulations.

“ Provided that if the circumstances are such that in the opinion of the Director, shippers ought reasonably to be permitted to ship in second hand bags, the Director may authorise the use thereof, but in any case, rice shall not be exported in old, torn or disfigured bags, and every second hand bag shall be of a quality approved by the Director, and every such bag before export must be securely sewn with overlapping edges and branded with the consignee’s mark.”

Made by the Governor in Council under section 8 of the Rice (Export Grading) Ordinance, 1930, (No. 18) as amended by section 5 of the Rice (Export Grading) Ordinance, 1932, (No. 40), this 25th day of September, 1939.
