Made Under

THE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE

(Chapter 145)

UNDER SECTIONS 141 AND 157 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE,  
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE  
CENTRAL BOARD OF HEALTH WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE  
PRESIDENT:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Potable Water Supply Regulations, 1971.

2. (1) Save as may otherwise be permitted under any law no person shall disrupt the supply of potable water to a building being used for human habitation except for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of effecting repairs to the pipe through which such supply is effected.

(2) Any person who contravenes this regulation shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars.
