

# BRITISH GUIANA.

REGULATIONS  
MADE UNDER  
THE EDUCATION ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 196).

UNDER SECTION 57 OF THE EDUCATION ORDINANCE  
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY  
THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Education Code (Amendment) Regulations, 1947, and shall be construed with the Education Code, 1940,\* hereinafter referred to as the Code.

2. Sub-regulation (7) of regulation 30 of the Code as substituted by regulation 3 of the Education Code (Amendment) Regulations, 1946,\*\* is hereby amended by the substitution of the words “after he has reached the Bar” for the words “immediately preceding the passing of the Bar” therein appearing.

3. Sub-regulation (3) of regulation 33 of the Code as substituted by regulation 3 of the Education Code (Amendment) Regulations, 1946, is hereby amended by the substitution of the words “after he has reached the Bar” for the words “immediately preceding the passing of the Bar” therein appearing.

4. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1944.
