

BRITISH GUIANA.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER THE LABOUR ORDINANCE, 1942, (No. 2 of 1942).

UNDER SECTION 35 (1) OF THE LABOUR ORDINANCE, 1942, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Hours of Work (Georgetown and New Amsterdam Watchmen) Regulations, 1947, and shall apply to the city of Georgetown as defined in section 4 of the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance and within one quarter mile of the boundaries thereof, and to the Town of New Amsterdam as defined in section 4 of the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance.

2. In these Regulations—

- “watchman” means any person employed to watch or guard any business premises or commercial undertaking.
3. The normal working hours for watchmen shall not exceed sixty-four hours a week.
4. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st August, 1947.
