

BRITISH GUIANA.

REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE MINING (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, (Chapter 175).

UNDER SECTION 98 OF THE MINING (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Bauxite Mining (Amendment) Regulations, 1947, and shall be construed with the Bauxite Mining Regulations, 1930, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Sub-regulation (1) of regulation 25 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the figures "25" for the figures "10" therein appearing.

3. Form No. 3 in the First Schedule to the Principal Regulations (which sets out the form of a bauxite mining lease) is hereby further amended—

(a) by the substitution of the following sub-clauses for sub-clauses (i) and (ii) of clause 2 thereof—

" (i) The Lessee shall pay royalty on all bauxite won or extracted from the said land and exported from the Colony at the rate of _____ cents a ton of 2,240 pounds as prescribed in the Bauxite Mining Regulations, 1930, or such amount as may from time to time be prescribed by any Ordinance or Regulations enacted or made after the date hereof.

(ii) The Lessee shall pay royalty on all bauxite won or extracted from the said land and used for manufacture in the Colony at the rate of _____ cents per ton of 2,240 pounds as prescribed in the Bauxite Mining Regulations, 1930, or such amount as may from time to time be prescribed by any Ordinance or Regulations enacted or made after the date hereof."

(b) by the substitution for the words "Royalty at the rate of ten cents a ton" in the first line of sub-clause (v) of clause 2 of the following—

"Royalty at the rate payable on bauxite exported from the Colony".
