REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE FACTORIES ORDINANCE, 1947,
(No. 30 of 1947).

UNDER SECTION 26 OF THE FACTORIES ORDINANCE, 1947,
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE
BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Hours of Work (Berbice Saw Mill Workers) Regulations, 1953.

2. In these Regulations—

“saw mill worker” means a person employed to perform manual labour in connection with the operation of a saw mill;

“saw mill” means any place where wood is prepared by mechanical process for building purposes.

3. The number of hours which may normally be worked by a saw mill worker in any week shall not exceed forty-five.

4. Any person who commits a breach of these Regulations shall, on a summary conviction, be liable to a penalty not exceeding fifty dollars.

5. It shall be the duty of the employer to keep posted in a conspicuous place on the premises one or more copies of these Regulations.

6. These Regulations shall apply to the County of Berbice.

7. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 26th day of September, 1953.
