REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE CUSTOMS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1952,
(No. 69 of 1952).

UNDER SECTION 273 OF THE CUSTOMS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1952, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Regulations, 1953, and shall be construed with the Customs Regulations, 1952,* hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 171 of the Principal Regulations, is hereby revoked and the following substituted therefor—

171. Fees according to the following scale shall be paid by persons requiring the services of officers at the extra attendance of officers. times or on days other than or in excess of those prescribed in regulation 169:

Provided that no fee shall be charged for any period of less than fifteen minutes.

1. Discharging general cargo	\$ 5.00
2. Discharging bulk cargo (coal, cement, bags, ammonia, and similar goods)	\$ 1.00
3. Discharging general cargo and loading general cargo, not including spirits	\$ 5.50
4. Loading general cargo	\$ 3.50
5. Loading bulk cargo	\$.50
6. Loading general cargo including spirits	\$ 5.00
Additional charge	\$ 1.00
7. Discharging or loading general cargo in midstream	\$ 2.50
8. Discharging or loading petroleum in bulk	\$ 2.00
9. Receiving at or delivering from a transit shed (per checking point)	\$ 2.00
10. Receiving at or delivering from a Government Warehouse	\$ 3.50
11. Examination outside Customs area	\$ 1.50
12. Attendance on passengers landing and embarking only	\$ 5.00
13. Watching general cargo, per supervision point	\$ 2.00
14. Watching spirits or bulk cargo, per supervision point	\$.50
15. Passing entries	\$ 1.50
16. Attendance on aircraft	\$ 2.00
17. Attendance on vessels proceeding to Mackenzie or Everton	\$25.00 for each vessel.
18. Entering or clearing vessels	\$ 2.00 for each vessel.

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1954.
