REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE MINING (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 175).

UNDER SECTION 98 (1) OF THE MINING (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Mining (Amendment) Regulations, 1954, and shall be construed and read as one with the Mining Regulations, 1931, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion after sub-regulation (7) of the following:—

“(8) A prospecting licence or an authority to prospect under a prospecting licence shall not be issued—

(a) to any person who is the holder either in his own name or for and on behalf of himself and other persons of a valid prospecting licence;

(b) to any person who is the holder of a valid authority to prospect under an existing prospecting licence.

(9) Any prospecting licence or authority to prospect under a prospecting licence issued contrary to the provisions of sub-regulation (8) of this regulation shall be null and void.”
