

# BRITISH GUIANA.

## REGULATIONS

### MADE UNDER

#### THE CURRENCY ORDINANCE, 1950, (No. 20 of 1950).

UNDER SECTION 12 OF THE CURRENCY ORDINANCE, 1950 THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS ARE, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CURRENCY, BRITISH CARIBBEAN TERRITORIES (EASTERN GROUP) AND WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE COLONIES, HEREBY MADE:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Currency (Notes) (Amendment) Regulations, 1954, and shall be construed with the Currency (Notes) Regulations, 1951\* hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Subregulation (3) of Regulation 20 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following substituted therefor—

“(3) Ordinary surveys shall be held at least quarterly and at least one surprise survey shall be held each year. The Governor may in addition at any time order a surprise survey to be held.”
