

BRITISH GUIANA.

REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE AIR NAVIGATION ACT, 1936,

(26 Geo. 5 & 1 Edw. 8, c. 44).

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE AIR NAVIGATION ACT, 1936, AS APPLIED TO THE COLONY BY THE COLONIAL AIR NAVIGATION (APPLICATION OF ACTS) ORDERS, 1937 TO 1947 THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Transport (Licensing of Air Services) (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be construed with the Air Navigation (Licensing of Air Services) Regulations, 1950, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same. Short title.
  2. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion after the definition of the word "permit" of the following new definition:  
 "provisional licence" means a licence granted under Regulations 14 or 15 of these Regulations;" Amendment of regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations.
  3. Regulation 4(1) of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion after the word "licence" of the words "or a provisional licence". Amendment of regulation 4(1) of the Principal Regulations.
  4. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion after regulation 29 of the following new regulation:  
 "References to 'licence' to include references to 'provisional licence'." Insertion of new regulation 29A.
- 29A. Any references to a licence in paragraphs (2) and (3) of regulation 6, regulations 20, 27, 28 and 30 of these Regulations shall be construed as including references to a provisional licence."
