REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 132).

UNDER SECTION 97 (h) OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE POSTMASTER GENERAL WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Private Letter Boxes (Amendment) Regulations, 1956.

2. Regulation 5 of the Private Letter Boxes Regulations* is hereby amended by the addition of the following new paragraph —

“(c) District offices other than New Amsterdam —

For a Box of No. 1 size	\$3.00
For a Box of No. 2 size	\$6.00
For a box of No. 3 size	.. \$9.00”
