

BRITISH GUIANA

REGULATIONS  
MADE UNDER  
THE LABOUR ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 103).

UNDER SECTION 35 OF THE LABOUR ORDINANCE, THE  
FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE  
GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Hours of Work (Georgetown and New Amsterdam Hire Car Chauffeurs) (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Hours of Work (Georgetown and New Amsterdam Hire Car Chauffeurs) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. The heading to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "GEORGETOWN AND NEW AMSTERDAM".

3. Regulation 1 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "Georgetown and New Amsterdam".

4. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of regulation 6, and by the re-numbering of regulations 7 and 8 as regulations 6 and 7 respectively.
