REGULATIONS
MADE UNDER
THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 309)

UNDER SECTION 273 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Regulations, 1960, and shall be construed and read with the Customs Regulations*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Appendix E to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended —

- (a) by the deletion of the word “cloth” appearing in condition (i), and the substitution therefor of the word “materials”;
- (b) (i) by the renumbering of condition (v) as condition (vi); and
- (ii) by the insertion after condition (iv) of the following condition—
“(v) Upon the exportation of products manufactured in the Colony from paper or paper board drawback in full of the duties paid on the importation of the paper and paper board used in the manufacture of such products.”
