REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE
(Chapter 280).

UNDER SECTION 103 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1957.

2. Regulation 195 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Regulations* is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following sub-regulation—

“(3) In sub-regulation (1) of this regulation “the Director of Public Works” includes any officer of the Public Works Department authorised by the Director of Public Works to act on his behalf for the purposes of the sub-regulation.”
