REGULATIONS

Made Under

ARTICLE 67(3) OF THE COLONIAL AIR NAVIGATION ORDER, 1955.

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED UPON THE GOVERNOR BY THE COLONIAL AIR NAVIGATION ORDER, 1955, AND OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS ARE HEREBY MADE:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Colonial Air Navigation (Medical Examination Fees) Regulations, 1957.

2. Paragraph 13 of Schedule IV of the Colonial Air Navigation Order, 1955, is hereby amended by the substitution of the fee of “£1. 15s.” for the fee of “15s.” appearing under the column “For official medical examination (if required)” in respect of the renewal of licences for—

- Commercial pilot (flying machines)
- Senior commercial pilot (flying machines)
- Airline transport pilot (flying machines)
- Commercial pilot (balloons)
- Airship pilot (first, second or third class)
- Commercial pilot (soaring gliders)
- Commercial pilot (trailing gliders).

3. Paragraph 14 of Schedule IV of the Colonial Air Navigation Order, 1955, is hereby amended by the substitution of the fee of “£1. 15s.” for the fee of “15s.” for an official medical examination.

4. Paragraph 16 of Schedule IV of the Colonial Air Navigation Order, 1955, is hereby amended by the substitution of the fee of “15s.” for the fee of “10s. 6d.” for special (audiometry) medical examination (if required).

5. Paragraph 20 of Schedule IV of the Colonial Air Navigation Order, 1955, is hereby amended by the substitution of the fee of “£1. 15s.” for the fee of “15s.”
