THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ORDINANCE, 1957,
(No. 3 of 1957).

UNDER SECTION 112 OF THE REPRESENTATION OF THE
PEOPLE ORDINANCE, 1957, THE FOLLOWING REGULA-
TIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN
COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Representation of the People (Proxies) (Extension of Time) Regulations, 1957, and shall be construed and read as one with the Representation of the People Regulations, 1957.

2. Regulation 9 of the Representation of the People Regulations, 1957, is hereby amended by the substitution for the word "tenth" in paragraph (1) and paragraph (7) thereof of the word "fifth".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations extend the time within which applications for the appointment of proxies and cancellations of such appointments shall be made by requiring such applications and cancellations to be made not later than the fifth day before polling day.
