REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE TRANSPORT AND HARBOURS ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 261).

UNDER SECTION 49(2) OF THE TRANSPORT AND HARBOURS ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GENERAL MANAGER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

Short title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Harbours and Pilotage (Amendment) Regulations, 1961, and shall be construed and read with the Harbours and Pilotage Regulations* hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

Amendment to the schedule.

2. The schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion after Part III thereof of the following part as Part IV.

“PART IV

There shall be a surcharge of \$8.00 on the fees for pilotage prescribed by Part I and Part III of this schedule in respect of the pilotage of any vessel that—

- (a) crosses the northern limit of the Harbour of Georgetown inward;
- (b) crosses the northern limit of the Harbour of Georgetown outward;
- (c) crosses the northern limit of the Harbour of New Amsterdam inward;
- (d) crosses the northern limit of the Harbour of New Amsterdam outward.”
