REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE
(CHAPTER 280)

UNDER SECTION 103 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1961, and shall be construed and read with the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Regulations* hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations and any Regulations amending the same.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st January, 1962.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion after regulation 28 of the following regulation—

“Driver’s licence to have photo-graph of holder affixed to it. 22A. (1) There shall be affixed by a licensing officer to every driver’s licence at the time of issue, other than a provisional licence, a photograph of the holder of the licence bearing a sufficient likeness to the said holder of the licence to the satisfaction of the licensing officer, and taken within five years immediately preceding the date of the application for the licence, such photograph being supplied by the applicant in duplicate at the time when application is made for the licence :

Provided that the licensing officer may, in his discretion, dispense with the requirement of supplying the photographs aforesaid when application is made for the renewal of a driver’s licence to which a photograph as hereinbefore described, has previously been affixed.

(2) No person shall fraudulently alter, deface or mutilate any driver’s licence or allow any such licence to be altered, defaced or mutilated.”
