THE BRITISH GUIANA RICE PRODUCERS ASSOCIATION ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 250).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE BRITISH GUIANA RICE PRODUCERS ASSOCIATION ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the British Guiana Rice Producers Association (Amendment) Regulations, 1962, and shall be construed and read with the British Guiana Rice Producers Association Regulations\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the following paragraph for paragraph (10) thereof —

“(10) If at the close of the nominations there are more candidates nominated than there are seats to be filled, the Returning Officer shall publicly declare that an election of the candidates will be held on the day appointed therefor and shall assign a symbol to each candidate: Provided that the Returning Officer shall not be precluded from assigning the same symbol to more than one candidate by reason only of the provisions of this Paragraph.”
