THE WIDOWS AND ORPHANS PENSION ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 75).

UNDER SECTION 53 OF THE WIDOWS AND ORPHANS PENSION ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE DIRECTORS OF THE WIDOWS AND ORPHANS FUND WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR ACTING IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Widows and Orphans Fund (Directors' Election) (Amendment) Regulations, 1962, and shall be construed and read with the Widows and Orphans Fund (Directors' Election) Regulations*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Paragraphs 1 and 4 of regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the substitution for the words "members of the Legislative Council" of the words "persons other than Public Officers".

3. Paragraph 2 of regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the word "ten" of the word "thirty".
