THE BRITISH GUIANA (SPECIAL SERVICE UNIT) ORDER
1964

UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE BRITISH GUIANA (SPECIAL SERVICE UNIT) ORDER 1964 AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING ME IN THAT BEHALF I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:

Citation. 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Special Service Unit (Amendment) Regulations 1965 and shall be construed and read with the Special Service Unit Regulations 1964.

Amendment of regulation 2. Regulation 67 of the Special Service Unit Regulations 1964 is hereby amended as follows —

(a) by renumbering the regulation as paragraph (1);

(b) by the insertion therein of the following paragraph as paragraph (2) —

(Vol. VIII p. 831) “(2) Until rules have been made with regard to any matter specified in paragraph (1) of this regulation the provisions of the Police Regulations relating thereto shall apply to the Unit as they applied to the Police Force on the 1st day of January 1952 and shall be construed with such adaptations and modifications as may be necessary to bring them into conformity with the provisions of these regulations; and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing references therein to the Commissioner and to the Force shall be construed as references to the Commanding Officer and to the Unit respectively and reference to a member of the Police Force of a specified rank as reference to a member of the Unit of corresponding rank.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations apply the Police Regulations relating to discipline and other matters to the Special Service Unit until such time as rules are made on these subjects by the Commanding Officer of the Unit.
