REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,

(CHAPTER 309)

UNDER SECTION 273 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Regulations, 1959, and shall be construed and read with the Customs Regulations, \* hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Appendix E to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended —

- (a) by the renumbering of condition (ii) as condition (iii); and
- (b) by the insertion after condition (i) of the following condition :

“(ii) upon —

- (a) the exportation, or
- (b) the deposit in a bonded warehouse for exportation, or
- (c) the deposit in a bonded warehouse for delivery to institutions approved by the Governor in Council,

of medicinal and pharmaceutical products as classified under group 541 of the Trade Classification List and Tariff set out in part I of this schedule, or of perfumery, cosmetics, soaps and cleansing preparations classified under group 552 of the Trade Classification List and Tariff set out in part I of this schedule, drawback in full of the duties paid on the importation of the materials used in the manufacture of such articles.”
