Made Under

THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT

(Cap. 36:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTIONS 20, 38, 39 and 51 OF THE NATIONAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the National Insurance and Social Security (Determination of Claims and Questions) Regulations^{Citation}*, may be cited as the National Insurance and Social Security (Determination of Claims and Questions) (Amendment) Regulations 1985.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion^{Amendment of the Principal Regulations.} after regulation 14 of the following regulation as regulation 14A —

14A. (1) Where a person who was the chairman or other member of any appeal tribunal is appointed as the Commissioner, a person qualified to be appointed as the Commissioner shall be appointed by the President as an **ad hoc** national Insurance Commissioner (hereinafter referred to as an **ad hoc** Commissioner) to hear and decide appeals from the decisions of that appeal tribunal to which the aforesaid chairman or member was a party.

(2) The term of office and other conditions of appointment of an **ad hoc** Commissioner shall be such as may be specified by the President.

(3) The provisions of these regulations in so far as they relate to the hearing and decision of appeals by the Commissioner, shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to and in relation to the hearing and decision by an **ad hoc** Commissioner of appeals referred to in paragraph (1).”
