Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Georgetown Town Council (Adaptation and Modification) (Belgrave Gratuity) Act, 1967.

Interpretation.

2. In this Act —

Cap. 152.

“the Principal Ordinance” means the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same; “the Council” has the same meaning as in the Principal Ordinance.

Authority to grant a gratuity to the widow of the late Harrie Emile Belgrave.

3. Section 96 of the Principal Ordinance shall be deemed to authorise the grant, in accordance with the provisions thereof save as otherwise provided by this Act, of a gratuity of four thousand and twenty-six dollars and sixty-seven cents to the widow of the late Harrie Emile Belgrave in respect of his service of the Council and, for the

purpose, the said provisions shall be construed with such modifications and adaptations as are necessary.
