ORDINANCE No. 14 of 1950.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance with respect to the exemption from taxation of certain land and buildings.

[8th April, 1950.]

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows: —

A.D. 1950.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Georgetown Town Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed and read as one with the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Short title.

Cap. 86.

2. Section one hundred and thirty of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the following for paragraph (j) —

Amendment of section 130 of the Principal Ordinance.

“(j) the provision of such proportion of the annual cost of the Public Free Library as may be agreed upon between the Governor in Council and the Council;”

3. Section one hundred and thirty-seven of the Principal Ordinance is hereby further amended by the deletion therefrom of the words “that portion of the building in Georgetown presently used as a museum under the control of the Royal Agricultural and Commercial Society, and so long as it is used for that purpose by the Society”, and the substitution thereof of the following —

Amendment of section 137 of the Principal Ordinance.

“the area of land described in the Schedule to the Georgetown Cultural Centre Ordinance, 1950 and any buildings erected thereon and used for the purposes of the Georgetown Cultural Centre established under the provisions of the said Ordinance”.
