ORDINANCE No. 28 OF 1950.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Marriage Ordinance, (Chapter 142).

[7th October, 1950.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:— **A.D. 1950.**

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Marriage (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed with the Marriage Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. **Short title.**  
**Cap. 142.**

2. Subsection (2) of section fifty-eight of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "twenty-five cents" of the words "forty cents". **Amendment or sub-section (2) of section 58 of the Principal Ordinance.**

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of January, 1950. **Commencement.**
