ORDINANCE No. 11 OF 1953.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) Ordinance with respect to Maintenance Orders.

[2nd May, 1953.]

A.D. 1953

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1953, and shall be construed and read as one with the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1A) of section forty-one of the Principal Ordinance as inserted by paragraph (f) of section two of the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1948, is hereby amended—

Amendment of section 41 of the Principal Ordinance. No. 26 of 1948.

(a) by the substitution for the words “until the final determination of the case” of the words “until the final determination of the case by the magistrate or, in the event of an appeal to the Full Court of Appeal from the decision of the magistrate, by the Full Court of Appeal.”;

(b) by the insertion between the word “that” and the word “the” in the first line of the proviso thereto, of the words “pending the making of a final order by the magistrate under subsection (2) of this section”.
