ORDINANCE No. 11 OF 1954.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Tax Ordinance, 1939.

[1st May, 1954]

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1954.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tax (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be construed and read as one with the Tax Ordinance, 1939, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Subsection (1) of section 4 of the Principal Ordinance as substituted by section 2 of the Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 1942, and amended from time to time is hereby further amended —

(a) by the substitution of a semicolon for the full stop at the end of the proviso thereto; and

(b) by the addition thereafter of the following further proviso —

“Provided further that any rum or other spirits, the produce or manufacture of the Colony, officially taken out of bond for the consumption of Her Majesty’s Armed Forces stationed in the Colony shall be exempt from duty.”

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 9th day of October, 1953.
