ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Audit Department Ordinance for the purpose of increasing the salaries of the Director of Audit and the Senior Auditor.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Audit Department (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Audit Department Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.


2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance as amended from time to time is hereby further amended —

- (a) by the substitution for the words “three thousand two hundred” appearing in subsection (1) of the words “three thousand three hundred”;
- (b) by the substitution for the words “one thousand seven hundred and fifty” appearing in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of the words “one thousand eight hundred”;
- (c) by the substitution for the words “one thousand four hundred and fifty” appearing in paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of the words “one thousand five hundred”.

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1954.
